RESOLUTION NO. 2020-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALISO VIEJO, CALIFORNIA SUPPLEMENTING ITS PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY REGARDING NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, as empowered by California Government Code section 8630 and Aliso Viejo Municipal Code 2.40.060, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-05 proclaiming a local emergency regarding novel coronavirus (COVID-19) and ratifying the Director of Emergency Services' March 16 proclamation of local emergency; and

WHEREAS, the imminent and proximate threat of introduction of COVID-19 in the City of Aliso Viejo continues to threaten the safety and health of City residents; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes, with this resolution, to supplement its proclamation to further address the local emergency; and

WHEREAS, this resolution will further assist in a coordinated public health response to reduce transmission and illness severity, provide assistance to health care providers, coordinate and mitigate public services that may be disrupted from this emergency, and mitigate any other effects of this emergency on the citizens of the City; and

WHEREAS, a declaration of a local emergency will assist in a coordinated public health response to reduce transmission and illness severity, provide assistance to health care providers, coordinate and mitigate public services that may be disrupted from this emergency, and mitigate any other effects of this emergency on the citizens of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALISO VIEJO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Pursuant to California Government Code section 8630 and Aliso Viejo Municipal Code Section 2.40.060 the City Council hereby reiterates its finding and proclamation of a local emergency caused by conditions or threatened conditions of COVID-19 pandemic in Aliso Viejo, which constitutes an extreme peril of health and safety of persons within the territorial limits of the City.

<u>Section 2</u>. The local emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the City Council.

<u>Section 3</u>. Any City-issued building permit, planning permit, or other entitlement that would have otherwise expired (1) during the pendency of this local emergency or (2) for which an application for extension was filed prior to this local emergency (i.e., prior to March 16, 2020) is hereby extended for 120 days.

Section 4. Per the California Department of Alcohol Beverage Control's (ABC) March 19, 2020 "Notice of Regulatory Relief," Type 47 (on-sale general – eating place) license holders may sell beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption off the premises and Type 41 (on-sale beer and wine – eating place) license holders may sell beer and wine, but not distilled spirits, for consumption off the premises. For the duration of the local emergency, the City requirements and conditions to the contrary of ABC's Notice of Regulatory relief in this respect are waived.

<u>Section 5</u>. During the existence of said local emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this City shall be those prescribed by state law, ordinances, and resolutions of the City of Aliso Viejo.
